DEPUTY WARDEN DUTIES

- * ON ARRIVAL AT THE WARDEN POINT, RECEIVE RED HELMET FROM FLOOR WARDEN.
- * ENSURE THERE ARE ENOUGH DEPUTY WARDENS TO HELP CHECK THE FLOOR.
- ♣ FOLLOW ANY INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN BY THE FLOOR WARDEN.
- ♣ IF REQUIRED, CHECK FLOOR FOR ANY OBVIOUS SIGNS OF SMOKE OR FIRE.
- * ADVISE ALL OCCUPANTS TO PREPARE FOR POSSIBLE EVACUATION.

 OCCUPANTS SHOULD REMAIN AT THEIR WORKSTATION UNLESS IN IMMEDIATE DANGER.

IF EVACUATION IS REQUIRED:

- * REMAINING DEPUTY WARDENS CONDUCT A SWEEP OF THE FLOOR TO CONFIM ALL OCCUPANTS ARE MOVING TO THE NEAREST SAFE EXIT STAIR.
- CHECK ALL TOILETS, MEETING ROOMS AND PAUSE AREAS. WHEN CLEAR, REPORT BACK TO THE FLOOR WARDEN WHO SHOULD BE WAITING AT THE WARDEN POINT (FIRE CABINET).
- * ASSIST MOBILITY IMPAIRED PERSONS INTO THE EMERGENCY STAIRWELL AND ADVISE FLOOR WARDEN. SOMEONE SHOULD WAIT WITH THEM.
- PROCEED DOWN THE STAIR TO THE EMERGENCY ASSEMBLY AREA (MUSTER POINT)
- ★ REMAIN AT THE ASSEMBLY AREA UNTIL GIVEN THE "ALL CLEAR" BY THE CHIEF WARDEN.
